# When should you use it?

---

1. If you have an article in your database results which looks just right from a context perspective, but it's a bit older than you would like, then you can use the article title to do a **citation search** in Scholar to see which, more recent papers have cited that particular article in their own work
2. If you come across a good article around your topic but you're struggling to find other articles, then you can do a citation search to see what papers have used the article you like in their own research



# Why should you use it?

---

**Hopefully the citing papers will:**

- (a) Be on the same / similar topic and therefore be useful to you
- (b) Be (a lot) more up to date than the paper you searched for
- (c) Have full-text available to read there and then


